### **SUMMARY:**

Establishes a consistent policy for providing historical documents to endorsed campaigns.

### **MAIN TEXT:**

It is the policy of the Fifth District Democrats to provide historical experiential information to endorsed candidates operating within the Fifth Legislative District. In addition, House and Senate candidates who are approved by the HDCC / SDCC can be provided this information following a simple majority vote of the Executive Board of the Fifth District. This information will be made available upon written or verbal request to the Chair.

In return, the candidate agrees to participate in a one hour long informal exit interview, to be held in November following the candidate's race, and to be conducted at the Issaquah Brewhouse (or similar venue). This will allow the Fifth District Democrats to continue improving our services for candidates.
